One of the main features of an "epic" is that the audiences, the readers already know the background of the poetry, the purpose of it and its ultimate outcome, but they are waiting for it to be awestruck. In the light of this feature, ELLS's journey was an epic, and the epic found its course when Md. Eftekhar Uddin started his tenure as the Chairman of the Department. The students of DELL have always demanded a full-fledged club, where they can engage themselves in various creative activities as well as develop appropriate leadership qualities among them. Such creative activities in university life enrich the student life of the learners, which later play a vital role in the development of viewpoint to life. Eftekhar sir himself felt the urge of the students' desire to form a creative student-run organization.

I still remember that Sir exchanged views with the student representatives on the day before taking office and gave guidance on the formation of ELLS on 9th March, 2016 though it's official journey was started on 22nd March, 2016 through forming a convening committee. When he called a meeting with us, we were curious to know what the new Chair of the Department might say to the students. We sat with him at the then library room of Old Campus where he shared his plans on what he wanted to do in his tenure and wished to establish a fully-fledged club. He gave us hopes and encouragement to assemble all the

We had a proactive meeting on that day where we also shared our thoughts regarding the club and some of us proposed a number of names for our desired club. Among them my classmate Tanvir's suggestion was "Silver Lining" which was preferred by most of the representatives. But it seemed to us that something is missing in the name. We wanted to select such a name which tend to have a more similarity with the department name and also reflects its connectivity with our department. Then Eftekhar Sir suggested the name "English Language and Literary Society" or ELLS in brief. The pronunciation of ELLS sounded more rhythmic to us than the previous name. The meeting was concluded with several decisions including the arrangement of inaugural ceremony of ELLS. Finally, on 26th March, we screened a film "Amar Bondhu Rashed" commemorating the independence day of Bangladesh where Eftekhar sir announced the commencement of ELLS.

Before the establishment of ELLS, the whole department was like the myth of the Garden and the Giant, which did not have a spring in it because the students had no opportunity to do any kind of creative work. After the formation of ELLS, the department's intense spring is flourished with various activities of the students. In spite of being students of English language, there was no Language Club. There was no opportunity to stage the drama as a student of literature. The birth of ELLS put an end to the impotence of social and creative activity of the department. Today there is no restriction on the development of new ideas of students. The students are exceeding themselves by implementing new ideas and engaging in new activities. They are upholding the name of the department as well as the university. ELLS is the name of our very own club full of endless possibilities which started three years ago but we hope it will flourish with more vigor in the upcoming years.
